

## NCRMA Offers \$2,500 Scholarships to High School Seniors!

DEADLINE: March 25, 2022

The North Carolina Retail Merchants Association (NCRMA) is proud to offer employees of its member companies the opportunity to apply to win a \$2,500 scholarship. Funded by the Association's charitable foundation, the Retail Consumer Alliance (RCA), twelve scholarships are awarded annually to high school seniors and college undergraduates.

#### Who Is Eligible

- High School Seniors enrolling for the 2022 fall semester who are a spouse or dependent of a permanent, full-time employee of an NCRMA retail member company. Employee must be employed for at least one year as of 1/1/22.
- Any student who at a minimum is a part-time employee of an NCRMA retail member company for at least six months as of 1/1/22.
- The retail industry employee, whether a parent, spouse, or student, must be employed with an NCRMA member company located in North Carolina at the time the winners are selected. Qualified scholarship recipients may attend a college located in any state.
- Two 2022 scholarships have been designated for a student who is currently attending a majority-minority high school or will be attending a Historically Black College or University in the fall. If either of those apply to you, please be sure to indicate it in the "College Information" and/or "High School Information" section.
- Previous winners are eligible to reapply.

- Scholarship winners will be selected by an independent academic scholarship evaluator.
- All applicants will be notified via email in June.
- Winners must be enrolled in college full-time for the 2022 fall semester.
- Scholarship awards will be mailed directly to the student and made payable to the college.

The applications are reviewed by an independent academic scholarship evaluator, and winners are determined based on objective, measurable point-based criteria established by the RCA Board.

Applicants agree that scholarship funds are to be used solely for educational purposes but are not limited to tuition only. If the applicant does not attend an educational institution in the school year for which scholarship funds were to be awarded or for a partial school year, the scholarship applicant acknowledges that they have no property or vested rights in the scholarship funds, that RCA maintains all rights to these funds, and the funds shall be returned to RCA by the educational institution.
